COVID-19 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

As we are being very cautious due to the current status of the Coronavirus, we have instituted the following policies. These are subject to change, and are in addition to our regular campground policies. All communication with the office must be made through the phone at 860-669-5388, or through email at riverdalefarmcampsite@comcast.net.

For any employees or customers who see potential violations of these rules, please call the state hotline for violations, at 211.

All reservations should be paid in full prior to arrival, over the phone with a credit/ debit card or through the mail with a check/ money order/ cash.

Face Masks

- Face masks are to be worn by all staff members and campers while in the campground
- While on your site, it is not required to wear a mask, however a mask should be at hand to be used immediately if needed. For example, if another camper approaches you.

Social Distancing

- Campers are expected to practice social distancing at all times. If approached by another camper, everyone is expected to step aside and maintain a distance of 6 or more feet apart.
- Campers from the same household and site are exempt to this rule while on their campsite.

Group Gatherings

- If not from the same household or campsite, gatherings are limited to NO MORE THAN 5 PEOPLE. Social distancing requirements apply as listed above.
- There are NO OUTSIDE VISITORS allowed at this time. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Recreational Areas Closed

- Currently, all recreational areas will be closed, including the swimming pond, all restrooms and showers, the main office, adult lounge, arcade, horseshoe pits, playgrounds, tennis court, basketball court, shuffleboard court, and laundry.

Main Office/ Camp Store

- The camp store will be closed to all in-person shopping. If campers would like to inquire about available items, the office will be open for phone calls. Purchases made will follow a no-contact procedure, in which the items are paid for over the phone, and are dropped off at the campsite by an employee.

Trash

- Campers are responsible for throwing ALL garbage into the dumpsters. If garbage is left behind, you will be banned from the campground.
- Mutt Mitts have been provided in the baseball field area, and should be disposed of in the main dumpster. Please be responsible for your pets.

On a positive note, we wish you and your families the best of summers and well-being. While there are numerous rules during this time, it is for the safety of all of us, from young to mature adults. Please be safe and our good wishes are with all of you.
